COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

GENERAL REFERENCES

Planning Commission — See Ch. 106.

§ 230-1. Statutory authority.

Pursuant to § 62.23(2) and (3), Wis. Stats., the Town of Middle Inlet is authorized to prepare and adopt a Comprehensive Plan as defined in § 66.1001(1)(a) and (2), Wis. Stats.

§ 230-2. Public participation.

The Town Board of the Town of Middle Inlet has adopted written procedures designed to foster public participation in every stage of the preparation of a Comprehensive Plan as required by § 66.1001(4)(a), Wis. Stats.

§ 230-3. Planning Commission recommendation.

The Planning Commission of the Town of Middle Inlet, by a majority vote of the entire Commission recorded in its official minutes, has adopted a resolution recommending to the Town Board the adoption of the document titled "Comprehensive Plan of the Town of Middle Inlet," containing all of the elements specified in § 66.1001(2), Wis. Stats.

§ 230-4. Public hearing.

The Town has held at least one public hearing on this chapter, in compliance with the requirements of § 66.1001(4)(d), Wis. Stats.

§ 230-5. Adoption.

The Town Board of the Town of Middle Inlet does by enactment of this chapter formally adopt the document titled "Comprehensive Plan of the Town of Middle Inlet" pursuant to § 66.1001(4)(c), Wis. Stats.¹
