

Chapter 262

FIRES AND FIRE PREVENTION

[HISTORY: Adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Middle Inlet as indicated in article histories. Amendments noted where applicable.]

ARTICLE I Fire Calls [Adopted 1-14-2010]

§ 262-1. Authority.

This article is adopted pursuant to the authority granted town boards under § 60.55(2)(b), Wis. Stats., which allows towns to recover the costs of fire calls made to property within the Town.

§ 262-2. Liability for fire protection costs; fee schedule.

- A. The Town of Middle Inlet, Marinette County, State of Wisconsin, hereby establishes the following fee schedule and imposes these charges for each fire call made within the limits of the Town of Middle Inlet:
- (1) Pumper No. 1 and No. 2: \$150 per hour each unit.
 - (2) Tanker No. 1 and No. 2: \$75 per hour each unit.
 - (3) Four by four truck: \$75 per hour.
 - (4) Equipment van: \$50 per hour.
 - (5) Fire Department staff: \$8 per hour.
- B. In the event that a fire call is not made to real estate located within the Town but instead made to personal property, such as a vehicle, the charges provided for under this article shall be imposed on all owners of such personal property.

§ 262-3. Processing of bills.¹

The billing procedure for all fire call fees will be completed as promptly as possible so as to facilitate any pending insurance claims.
